The Masorti Bet-El Community, house of G-d, began its activities in 1991 with the aim of providing religious guidance, cultural and religious services within the line of the Masorti movement - conservative and Ashkenazi tradition. Our religious services follow most of the traditional framework with the aim of transmitting the values of Zionism, modernity and dialogue, with an important characteristic: the place of women, which has an equal status to men. The study of texts, through reflection and discussion occupies a prominent place. The classes taught are held in an open and plural framework. Hebrew is the liturgical language of the majority of prayers, but translation and phonetics are available, so that everyone can follow the service. Since 2004 we have a place where we carry out a large part of our activities. Today about 120 families from Madrid and surroundings participate in our activities.
